Introductions

Administration – Mr. David Maxwell, Assistant Principal Activities

Mr. Maxwell met with coaches on May 30th during which he discussed his style of leadership to be one of “decentralized leadership”.

Secretary Monthly Report:

Report reviewed and accepted as submitted.

Treasurer’s Monthly Report:

Balance of \$252,612.00 as of May 31, 2023. Discussion of wanting to uniform between activities how fund raising funds are utilized/treated. Clarification that T&A accounts which are tax deductible are separate from the individual activity booster club accounts which are not tax deductible.

Old Business:

T-shirts for All: Move to approve April Lovrine, second Angie Stewart. Motion by April Lovrin for \$1000 to be moved to the TFA account for Patriot Power Day (like last year), second by Megan Pederson. There will be 2100 shirts and a goal of raising \$11,500.

Booster Club Meeting Dates: Change of Booster Club dates for 2023/2024 school year. Usually 2nd Monday of the month but two changes made because of no school conflicts. Those changes include October 9th changed to the 16th and March 11th changed to the 4th. No July 2023 meeting.

New Business:

Patriot Power Day on August 9th. Sign up genius going out for AM and afternoon shifts (4-5 volunteers per shift). RWB giving out activity passes at PPD but can be given out at later date as well. Importance of RWB going out in an email and will also be in the newsletter. LHS students can use RWB passes from parental donation so they don't have to buy their own. Old RWB form is online but new form waiting approval from Casey Meile/LHS Booster Club Board. Mention emailing out form to parents in booster club member's individual activities. Discussion of activity passes for non-LHS students (middle and elementary students) are \$20 but not currently promoted. We would like to include that info in future Patriot Newsletter.

Booster club reps for 2023/24: Karen Lechtenberg sent out an email and found that 60% of booster club members not staying mostly because of student graduating. Attendance by each activity is again necessary to receive funds for the following school year. "Cracking down" will be starting in August. Eighty percent attendance will be required (8 of 10 meetings) by at least one activity booster representative. Signing in important and required.

Air Show Fundraiser—The Air Show is once every 3 years. The next one is July 29 & 30, 2024. Chuck Nelson, LHS Alum, does our taxes as an in kind donation, reached out to us for 4 activity volunteers to cover 4 tents selling souvenirs. Ten percent of all sales after taxes will be split between the 4 activities. In the past it was \$4500-\$5000 total. We will take the first four activities to commit. He will get back to us on time and details.

LHS Happenings:

David Maxwell will do scheduling for banquets/etc. in the future to minimize conflicts going forward. This year there was a conflict with the track and field banquet and softball games.
