- Motion to approve financials by Sarah Sarbacker, 2nd by Joni Merkley. Motion passed

Old Business:

Mascot

- Mascot-Kjerstin Smith reported students voted & chose a clear front-runner.
- Once payment is approved it can be customized and takes 6-9 weeks
- Mascot head has built-in fan and the costume fits size 5'7" to 6'1" person
- Motion to order mascot & carrying bag for total of \$3525 made by Kjerstin Smith and 2nd by Kathy Nash
- Motion amended to add \$200 cooling vest by Kjerstin Smith, 2nd by Sarah Sarbacker for a total of \$3725 approved. Motion passed.
- Discussion-cheer coach get the word out re: mascot volunteer opportunities

T-shirts For All (TFA) Committee

- Kjerstin Smith reports that they met with Charlie Kneip. He proposes a \$5,000 sponsorship (similar to what he does for RHS) with sole sponsorship on shirt
- Looking at Monarch Sales--approx. \$4.40 per shirt (more for XXL sizes)
- Estimating \$10,000 total based on student attendance numbers
- Still working on figuring best way to get sizes and distribution logistics

- Motion made by Sarah Sarbacker for Booster Club to cover t-shirt cost difference above the \$5,000 donation. 2nd by Anita Wetsch. Motion Passed

New Business:

- **New Hallway Record Boards**--moved to next meeting agenda when G. Gohl is present
- **Booster Club By-Laws**--by-laws to be published on website and distributed by email in the interest of transparency
- **Booster Club Rep List**—process started to update current mailing list of reps before Aug, and also a request to email a photo to Kristin Brown for making a Booster photo directory
- **FUN RUN**—clarification that no one is REQUIRED to participate, but that WHS has challenged each activity to enter one participant or team. Kristin Brown to send out info via parent email list this week.
- **HUDL**—Coach Fredenburg explained the subscription costs for individual teams vs entire school and the savings involved, ways all the activities might benefit. Asking for consideration of a cooperative effort between teams/activities to cover this \$9,300 school HUDL subscription for max cost-to-benefit. Reps to go to activities/teams and see if interest/support is there. Vote tabled until Aug.
